

TOYOTA  **2010**



Event Report, Round 3, Sculthorpe, 6th June 2010

Now in its third year,, the Toyota Sprint Series contenders visited a new location for round three of the 2010 championship. Sculthorpe, in Norfolk provided 2 miles of large airfield track with more open and sweeping corners to stretch all cars and drivers limits.

The event was expertly run by track day specialists Javelin with support from Blitz-UK, Millers Oils, Fensport, Super-Pro Bushes, Merlin International, AEW Graphics, and the GT4 OC.

Threats of thunder also provided excitement to the day, along with the changing surface on the track suggesting high skills were required to keep the cars going forwards.

By lunchtime however it had remained dry, and hot, and many drivers had already found the limits of the track and their cars. In the three timed runs up to lunch, Adrian Smith in the Celica GT4-X had put in a time of 103.49, his closest competitor Jonny Milner answering with a 104.11 in the Celica GT4.

With lunchtime over and the clouds getting darker and lower, the competitors had discussed the best lines and the slipperiest parts of the track and were ready to go. Two more timed runs were had in the afternoon, and most drivers were improving with every run. Unfortunately Milner suffered a gearbox issue and did not improve on his morning times.

The thunder appeared after run 5, and with it came torrential rain. It was decided to run the next few runs with no timing as the drivers wanted to have some fun in the wet on this open track, and the wet weather would not allow anyone to improve their times. This was met with approval from the competitors, especially Dave 'sideways' Brooks in his Starlet 4AGE.



Results in class order:



Class F – Up to 1.0l

Paul Thomas (above left) in his Aygo once again dominated the 1.0L class with his times slowly increasing throughout the day, ending in a 130.91 on run 5. Runner up was Dan Quinn in his Yaris with a time of 132.91 also set in his final run.



Class D – Up to 1.6l Normally Aspirated

Despite spending most of his time on the track sideways, David Brooks was loving the "Rally Style" track layout and proved unbeatable with his time of 117.7 set in run 2. Chasing was Neil Latham in the MR2 20v with a time of 122.82.



Class C – Over 1.6l Normally Aspirated

Craig Storey (above left) was pushing hard in his Celica ST182 and after scattering some cones in previous runs bagged a class winning time of 119.35, this time also earning him the 'hard charger' award, given to one driver at each round who punches above his weight. Chasing hard was Alex Meade in his Supra who so narrowly missed out by only 3 hundredths of a second with his time of 119.38.



Class B – Up to 1.6l Forced Induction

Darren Burwash (above left) used the power in his Starlet Turbo to great effect and were well suited to this track setting a time of 115.94 to take the class win and 4th Overall. Runner up was Barrie Newsome (above right) in his Starlet Turbo with a time of 119.47.



Class A3 – Over 1.6l Forced Induction

A strong time of 111.15 won this class, set by Barry Watling (above left) in his Celica GT4. Chris Cooke (above right) chased hard all day, had a few spins on track and ended up 2nd in class in his MR2 Turbo with 115.94.



Class A2 – Over 1.6l Forced Induction - Modified

Only one entrant in this class this time and Nigel Levinson's time of 120.30 got him the class trophy in his newly rebuilt Celica GT4.



Class A1 – Over 1.6l Forced Induction – Highly Modified.

Unstoppable this round was Adrian Smith (above left) in his Celica GT4-X, the 2 mile long track certainly suited the powerful A1 cars and Adrian took full advantage to put in a flying time of 103.49. Jonny Milner (above right) answered with a 104.11, before a gear selection problem then rain put paid to his last 2 runs.




