


# RRG TOYOTA SPRINT SERIES

## Event Report - Round 6 - Rockingham - 1st November 2014

Round 6, the final round of the series was at Rockingham Motor Speedway in Northamptonshire. The sprint circuit designed by Javelin used a mix of the famous oval combined with hairpin, chicanes, off camber corners and some tight but sweeping bends making for a great test of driver skill.



47 entrants arrived early morning to a very damp and cool Rockingham, as the cars set off on the practise laps the track was very slippery but the sun was shining and the track was drying. By mid morning the track was dry and the times came tumbling down.

Pressure was spread over the 14 different classes, as this was the final round, and the championship positions were in the minds of many!

## Results In Reverse Class Order



### **Class D Street** – Up to 1.6 Normally Aspirated

A massive 9 cars in class D street, 7 Yaris, 1 Corolla and 1 Starlet competed to see who would be the fastest. Dan Quinn in his Corolla was fastest in the wet and slippery 1st runs, but it was Dave Brookowski (above) an ex TSS Champion returning to the series who took the lead from run 5, and went on to win by a mere 0.95s in his Yaris SR.



### **Class D Pro** – Up to 1.6 Normally Aspirated

Martin Lush in his AE86 (above) once again dominated D pro leading from the start and beating his team mate. Martin went on to record a stunning 1.24:32 good enough for 5th overall !



**Class C Street** - Over 1.6 Normally Aspirated

Another good close battle was between Peter Mason in his MR2 (above) and Richard Mackay in his 2 litre Celica both swapping tenths until run 4 where Peter edged out a lead to win the class with a 1:29.73



**Class C Pro-** Over 1.6 Normally Aspirated

Chris Girdler on his own in class, but pushing hard in his Celica, (sideways above) and setting his fastest time on run 5, a 1:28.52 to take the class win.



**Class B Street – Up To 1.6 Forced Induction**

Vit Seebaluck took control of B Street from the off against team mate Anuj Seebaluck. Both driving the same Starlet Turbo (above) Vit took class honours with a 1.26:38



**Class B Pro – Up To 1.6 Forced Induction**

Barrie Newsome (above) had a big spin on the damp run 1 and collected a void, but after that he settled down and produced some great times finishing 1st in class and 4th overall with a 1.21.88. James Abbot in his Starlet had a great tussle with Phil Cutler in his MR2 Supercharger, James just pipping Phil by a mere 7/100ths of a second!



### **Class A3 Street – Over 1.6 Forced Induction**

Another popular class is A3 Street, 7 car this time around and competition was fierce! at the top of the class was Jay Wood (above) and Andrew haw both driving similar spec Celica GT4's. The lead changed between them on virtually every run, but it was Jay who pulled a 0.28s lead on run 5 setting a 1.24:54 to clinch the class win.



### **Class A3 Pro – Over 1.6 Forced Induction**

Joe Tapply in his supercharged Celica (above) was all on his own in class A3 Pro but still trying hard and recording a 1:29.09 for the class win.



### **Class A1 Pro - Over 1.6 Forced Induction**

2 cars in the big power class, Nigel Levinson took the lead on run 1 using the 4wd from his Celica GT4 in the slippery conditions and Luke Lawrence (above) bid his time and took the lead on run 2, the pair continued to swap fastest times till Luke set a stunning 1.19:26 on run 5 to take the class win and 2nd Overall.

### **GT86 Trophy**



The GT86 Trophy series is run within the TSS championship. The cars score for their own series as well as overall TSS honours. There were 14 cars entered for Rockingham, spread over 5 different classes depending on their modifications. There is also a class for the showroom standard car.



### **Class N3 - Standard**

N3 is the "showroom" class for completely standard cars. 4 entrants in the class and some close competition, just 0.73 s covering the top 3 makes for exciting racing! Alec Keeler (above) and Fraser Shaw were literally swapping tenths all day and Alex Shaw was building speed all the time. It went down to the very last run, all three drivers setting their fastest times, it was Alec Keeler who stole the number 1 spot with a 1.32:35s on the very last run!



### **Class N2 - Normally Aspirated - Modified - Street**

N2 may be the home of the lightly modified GT86, but beware, they are extremely quick! Stan Hawrylak (above) and Lauren Blighton were at the front of the class and soon set about setting fast times! Stan set a blistering 1.24:61 on run 4, good enough for the class win and 8th overall.



**Class N1** - Normally Aspirated - Modified - Pro

N1 is for the modified normally aspirated GT86. The only entrant this time, Kevin Atkins, an ex Time Attack Champion, was getting his first taste of TSS and thoroughly enjoyed his day! Kevin (above) set a 1.31:21.



**Class F2** - Forced Induction - Street


The home of turbo and super charged GT86's Class F2 had 4 entries this time, Rob Swindon took the early lead but then suffered a coil problem and a void run, Masaya Yumeda grabbed the lead from run 3 and took the class win with a great time of 1.24:53, good enough for 6th overall.



**Class F1** - Forced Induction - Pro

He may be alone in the GT86 pro class, but Adrian Smith (above) doesn't hold back! On the pace from the word go, and dicing with the powerful A1Pro cars of Luke Lawrence and Nigel Levinson. As the track dried, Adrian pushed harder and harder setting faster times with each run until a traction control problem, (driver forgot to switch it off!) on the last run. Adrian went on to the class and overall win with a stunning 1:17.61.
